ORDINANCE NO. 2020-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TYRONE,
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING §8-504.B
OF THE TYRONE TOWNSHIP CODIFIED ORDINANCES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tyrone (the "Township"), Adams County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8-504.B of the Tyrone Township Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§8-504. Pumping Requirements; Report Required; Additional Maintenance.

B. The Township shall publicize within each of the sewage management districts served by on-lot sewage systems that on-lot sewage systems must be pumped and inspected in accordance with the schedule set forth in Section 8-504.A. Any person owning a building served by an on-lot sewage system within one of the sewage management districts, which contains a treatment tank, shall have the tank pumped and inspected by a registered pumper/hauler. The property owner must have his system pumped and inspected within the time period specified in Section 8-504.A unless he can provide the Township with a receipt or other written evidence showing that his tank has been pumped and inspected within the past one year period. Property owners providing such written documentation, satisfactory to the Township, can request that the Board of Supervisors grant a postponement of the initial required pumping and inspection until the end of a three-year period following enactment of this Part. The decision to grant or deny the request will be final.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted and enacted as if such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included therein.

SECTION 3: REPEALER.

Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.
