

**TYRONE TOWNSHIP OF ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 59**

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**AN ORDINANCE OF TYRONE TOWNSHIP PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF  
WEAVER ROAD (T-563) & LIME ROCK MILL ROAD (T-556) LOCATED WITHIN  
THE BOUNDARIES OF TYRONE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XXIII OF  
THE PENNSYLVANIA SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE**

**WHEREAS**, Article XXIII of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code authorizes the Tyrone Township Board of Supervisors to vacate any road located wholly or partially within Tyrone Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tyrone Township Board of Supervisors wishes to vacate Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556), more particularly described in Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Sections 2304 and 2305 of the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. 67304 and 67305) as amended, the Tyrone Township Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on October 18, 2017 after providing ten (10) days written notice to all owners of property adjacent to Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556) or portions thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tyrone Township Board of Supervisors, after considering the testimony offered at the public hearing, has determined that the vacation of Weaver Road and Lime Rock Mill Road is in the best interests of the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Tyrone Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

**SECTION I**

Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556) (as is more particularly described on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) is

hereby vacated, and Tyrone Township relinquishes any right, title, interest, obligation, or duties in and to the above-described Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556).

## **SECTION II**

The resultant title to Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556), as described in Exhibit "A", shall vest according to law.

## **SECTION III**

If any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Tyrone Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such stricken provisions not been included herein.

## **SECTION IV**

All other Ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions hereof are repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

## **SECTION V**

This Ordinance shall be codified in the Codified Ordinances of Tyrone Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, and shall amend such codification as necessary to codify this Ordinance, including the removal of all references to Weaver Road (T-563) and Lime Rock Mill Road (T-556) and the amendment of Section 7-213, Section 7-301, and Appendix 2 of such Codified Ordinances.

## **SECTION VI**

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.
